Alumni of the Year Award

Purpose: To recognize and honor alumni who represent the best of Daytona State College by bringing positive change to their community, state, nation or the world.

Criteria: To be considered for the Alumni of the Year award, an individual must meet the following criteria:

- Be distinguished among his/her peers for constructive contributions made to society that display leadership, responsibility and expertise in his/her field of endeavor;
- Have a record of community involvement;
- Be a person of integrity who has demonstrated ability to bring dignity and inspiration to the faculty, staff, students, alumni and friends of Daytona State College;
- Be an individual whose deeds reflect the importance of his/her education.

A person may receive this award only once in his/her lifetime.

Distinguished Faculty/Staff Award

Purpose: To recognize current or former faculty or staff of Daytona State who have demonstrated consistent dedication and superior service at the college.

Criteria: Award nominees must be current or former full-time, part-time or adjunct faculty or staff of the college. They must demonstrate a commitment to the mission of the college and the DSC Foundation and show a record of outstanding contributions to their profession. These contributions may or may not have come during their college tenure, but must reflect highly on the college.

Young Alumni Excellence Award

Purpose: To recognize the exceptional professional achievements of a young alumnus and/or alumna of Daytona State who has made outstanding contributions to his or her community.

Criteria: Award nominees shall be 35 years or younger and have made significant contributions and achievements, as well as having demonstrated promise in their profession and made outstanding contributions to their community.

The Margaret Crumley Award for Distinguished Achievement in Science

Mrs. Margaret Crumley established this award in honor of her son, John, and husband, Thomas.

Purpose: To honor an alumnus who achieved an associate degree from the School of Biological and Physical Sciences at Daytona State and who has made significant contributions in their field.

Nominations/Selection: Recipients are nominated and selected by science faculty.

Criteria:

The award recipient must:

- Have graduated from Daytona State with an associate degree in a science-related discipline;
 - Be working in a science-related field (or be retired from a science-related field);
 - Use scientific knowledge to improve their community and;
 - Have distinguished themselves in their chosen scientific field.

Nominations may be submitted to the Alumni Relations Office. A completed nomination form must be submitted to Alumni@DaytonaState.edu or faxed to (386) 506-3014 no later than August 16, 2019.

Selecting Body

The Honorary Awards Committee makes the final selection of award recipients.

Exception: The Margaret Crumley Award for Distinguished Achievement in Science will be determined by the science faculty.
